Project one: Develop and perform research for various Verité initiatives that reference key aspects of country labor law related to standard corporate codes of conduct including:

- Child Labor
- Special Provisions for Women Workers
- Freedom of Association & Collective Bargaining
- Employment Practices and Personnel Policies
- Wages
- Benefits
- Hours of Work
- Contract Labor
- Health and Safety

This research is conducted for various stakeholders including multinational brands, advocacy organizations and the general public and governments that seek information on worker protections in global supply chain production.

Project two: To review updates in a wide variety of international labor standards publications for the Emerging Markets Research Project; a multi-year initiative to research relevant information on labor standards compliance in 27 emerging market countries around the world. The Intern will update existing country reports based on any new information in the most recent versions of the publications listed below. Tasks include review of publications, insertion of new information; provide brief analysis of countries' performance based on the updated information

Types of publications to be reviewed include U.S. State Department Human Rights Reports; U.S. Department of Labor "Foreign Labor Trends" Country Reports ; "Worst Forms of Child Labor"; "Advancing the Campaign Against Child Labor: The Resource Allocations of National Governments and International Financial Institutions"; Human Rights Watch World Reports; Amnesty International reports, etc.
